CREDIT & DEBIT CARD SECURITY TIPS

- DO NOT give out your card number over the phone unless you initiated the call.
- Always keep your card in a safe, secure place. Please contact us immediately if your card becomes lost or stolen.
- Memorize your PIN number. DO NOT keep your PIN number with your card.
- When selecting a PIN, never use any words or numbers that are tied to your name, address, birthdate or phone number.
- Change your PIN number on a regular basis.
- Cancel and destroy any unused cards.



SHOPPING ON THE INTERNET

When making an internet purchase, look for secure transaction symbols on the website you are visiting such as:

- Lock symbol located in the lower right hand corner of the web browser.
- A website that reflects “**https://**” in the address bar of the website. The “**S**” indicates the site is “**SECURE**” and uses encryption.
- Always log off from any website after you complete a transaction.



AT THE ATM

- Have your debit card ready as you approach the ATM – DO NOT fumble in your pocket or purse to find it when you are at the ATM.
- Be aware of your surroundings – if anything looks suspicious DO NOT enter and call the police.
- DO NOT use ATMs that look in disrepair or altered in any way.
